THE OHIO STATE UNIVERSITY 2024 EMPLOYER SURVEY REPORT


This report highlights employment skills and experiences that employers value when hiring recent Ohio State graduates for full-time roles.

- Data were collected at the Buckeye Careers University-wide Career and Internship Fair on September 18, 2024 using iPads. A follow-up survey invitation was emailed to employers that were present at the fair but did not complete the survey.
- Of the 204 employers at the career fair, 96 responded, yielding a 47.1% response rate.
 - For 75% of employers that responded, the majority of their job openings were for jobs in Ohio.

Findings

91% of employers rate Ohio State graduates as well or exceptionally prepared for work.

Over half of employers at the career fair think that Ohio State graduates excel at the following skills in relation to graduates from other universities:

Professionalism (59%), Career & Self-Development (56%), Communication (51%)



Employer Importance Versus Recent Graduate Proficiency

Of Ohio State employers, **99%** consider communication skills **very/extremely important** for hiring recent graduates with three-quarters (**74%**) rating recent Ohio State graduates as **very/extremely proficient** in this area at graduation.

The National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE) found that **96%** of employers rate communication skills as **very/extremely important** when hiring recent graduates across the United States but only **47%** rate recent graduates nationally as **very/extremely proficient** in this area.



¹Importance represents the percentage of employers that rated a competency as either "very important" or "extremely important" when hiring recent graduates. Proficiency represents the percentage of employers who found recent Ohio State graduates "very proficient" or "extremely proficient" in that competency.
