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INTRODUCTION

The Ohio State University Undergraduate and Master's/Professional Graduation Surveys were first administered in the spring term of 2011 and are administered at the end of each term by the Office of Student Life. The surveys gather information about the experiences, satisfaction and career and education plans of graduating students, as well as their permanent contact information. This report presents the results from the last five academic years. Please note that the COVID-19 pandemic may have affected responses for the 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 academic years.

DESIGN

The surveys were designed by representatives from the Registrar's Office, the Office of Institutional Research and Planning, the Office of Student Life, University Communications and the Alumni Association. Two surveys were developed - one for undergraduates and one for students earning Master's or professional degrees. Graduate students completing PhDs are not surveyed because PhD graduates are invited to take the Survey of Earned Doctorates, which duplicates many of items on the Graduation Survey.

The surveys include the following sections: future contact information, students' satisfaction with Ohio State, students' immediate career plans, students' future education plans and the amount of debt incurred in pursuit of their degrees. In addition, undergraduate students are asked questions about the curriculum and about their co-curricular experiences.

Since 2011, the surveys have undergone several revisions. Some items have been added or changed, and some response options have been edited to better reflect student perspectives. This report compares findings when multiple years of data are available.

INVITATIONS AND RESPONSE RATES

Students who applied to graduate each term were invited to take the appropriate survey. If students planned to graduate with more than one degree, they received only one invitation. If students planned to graduate with both an undergraduate and graduate degree in the same major, they were invited to take the Master's/professional survey. If a student planned to graduate with both a Master's and professional degree from the same college, they are counted as a professional student in reporting. Response rates for each of the academic years, by degree obtained, are presented in the table below.





Looking back, how satisfied are you with your experience as a student at Ohio State overall? (Undergraduates)




Reflecting back, to what extent do you agree that the benefits you have received from attending Ohio State were worth the financial costs to you and your family? (Undergraduates)






DEBT










To what extent have your overall undergraduate experiences influenced your plans for graduate or professional studies? (Undergraduates)
















To what extent have your overall graduate experiences influenced your plans for graduate or professional studies? (Master's)









Which of the following best describes your current state of plans for employment after graduation? (Professional)











